



New teaching facility, Mount St Marys Catholic High School

We want to share the latest designs for our state-of-the-art new teaching block at Mount St Marys CHS.

The project involves construction of a new Net Zero Carbon in Operation education facility to replace the existing 1960's block, which will be demolished. The works include replacing the windows and roof to the Grade II listed building.

The new teaching accommodation includes general teaching and science classrooms, together with a new main kitchen and dining hall.

Building work is due to begin in 2025 and the new building is expected to be completed in Spring 2026. Refurbishment of the listed building and demolition of the redundant building will follow, with all building works anticipated to be complete in Autumn 2027.

The project has been carefully planned to ensure the school can remain fully operational throughout construction and ensure minimal impact on neighbours.

We will shortly be submitting a planning application for the development and would like to get your views on the proposed development before finalising the detailed design.
